2023 & 2024 Workdays

Last week, I sent a workday report to the Steering Committee which details how many hours each member was required to complete in 2023, how many hours each member completed in 2023 and how many hours each member will be required to complete in 2024. The report shows that approximately one third of garden members did not complete all or part of their garden workday hours. This percentage is unacceptable.

We are not terminating anyone's membership this year, even though we have the right to do so, because many of the scheduled workdays were postponed and/or cancelled due to inclement weather. However, we are looking at ways to reduce or eliminate the practice of carrying over unworked hours to the following garden season.

Once we define the 2024 Workday Schedule, Garden members are encouraged to carefully select workdays that do not coincide with their personal known schedules like, conferences or conventions, sports events, vacation plans, etc.

2024 Garden Needs

This year, we hope to replenish stone dust and playground chips throughout the common areas of the garden, and we hope to order compost for your plots. We postponed purchasing some of these items for several years due to Covid restrictions and, last year, due to inclement weather. We hope the reconstruction of the nearby playground and bike path, and inclement weather, will not interfere with our plans.
