In Memory of Angelo Messina

We recently learned that we lost another friend and former garden member, Angelo Messina. The cause of his death is unknown.

Angelo authored a book entitled A Durable Remission: Surviving Brain Cancer. This is the true story of a man's journey of Angelo's survival through stage 4 brain cancer, diagnosed in 2004. After over 3 years of chemo therapy, he continued to be in remission for 14 years. In the fall of 2016, Angelo was diagnosed with prostate cancer. Again after 6 rounds of strong chemo, he continued to be in remission and lead a very active and social lifestyle. His book is available on Amazon and a portion of the proceeds is donated to brain cancer research.

A memorial service will be held in Massachusetts sometime in May. We'll share the date if more information becomes available.
